It is really important that you attend this appointment, as your child's teacher will want to discuss how they have settled in to their new class and the next steps they need to take in their learning.

**Asthma:**

Asthma is the most common long-term medical condition affecting children and adults - nearly 10% of the population suffer from asthma.

Did you know?

- If your child has been diagnosed with asthma, they are entitled to reviews of their medication and treatment on an **annual** basis and **after any asthma attack**.
- If your child's asthma is not managed properly, they could have a severe asthma attack which may result in hospitalisation. Therefore, regular check-ups and consultations after any asthma attack are essential.

Please contact your Doctor's surgery to arrange an asthma review.
