Add marks to work which to them resemble their name.

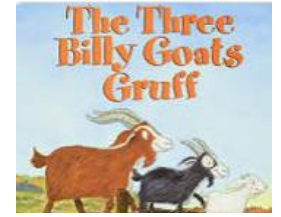
Communication and Language

Traditional Tale



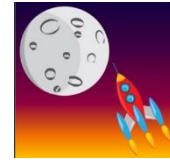
Vocabulary
