Reading at home

We encourage our children to read regularly at home. This helps secure their phonics knowledge and develops their fluency and comprehension skills. We like parents to support this by sitting with your child and discussing the books they read.

Medicine

Any medicine that your child needs throughout the day should be brought to the school office. You will need to fill in a medication form giving details of the medicine, time and dose required. The medicine must then be collected by a parent/carer from the office at the end of the day. If your child requires an inhaler for asthma, there should be one given to school.

Food and Drink

Children in Year 3 and 4 can pay for a hot lunch provided by Shire Services and ordered on Parent Pay. A full menu is available from school. Children are provided with a free piece of fruit during the morning and milk is available to purchase through our milk supplier. Children who receive free school meals (not universal) are entitled to free milk. Children bring a healthy packed lunch if they are not having a hot dinner. Some children receive free school meals. If you claim benefits and think you may be able to claim free school meals, please contact the school office.



Uniform

Our school uniform consists of the following:-

White polo shirt

Red sweatshirt/cardigan. This can be with or without the school logo.

Grey/black trousers (for boys or girls)

Grey skirt/pinafore.

Red and white gingham dress in summer if you wish.

Black shoes. No trainers are permitted.

Please name all uniform and PE kit

P.E

White t-shirt (with or without school logo) red shorts and black pumps.

Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled with their name.



Reporting an absence

We continue to emphasise the importance of children attending school. In any case of an absence, it is the parent/guardian's legal duty to let the school know.

We need your name, your child's name, your child's class and the reason for their absence.
