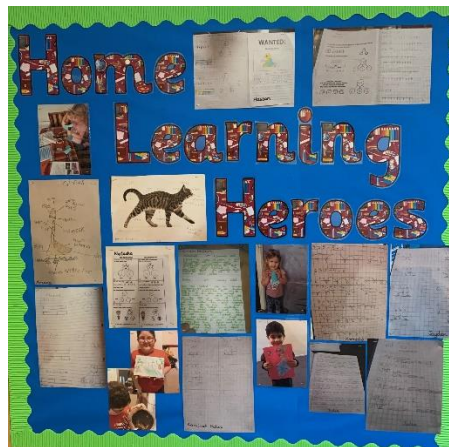

World Book Day:


