Dear Parents and Carers,

The children are very much enjoying their new topics for this half-term and are working very hard. The children in Early Years are learning about traditional tales through their 'Once upon a time...' topic and really enjoyed their visit from a storyteller last week. The children in Years 1 and 2 are doing a topic called 'Fire, Fire' where they are learning about the Great Fire of London. In Years 3 and 4 the children are learning about where our food comes from through a topic called 'Food, Glorious Food'.

Please remember that if you are an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen, you and your family members should apply to the EU Settlement Scheme by Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June. Eligible children are required to have an application in their own right because no child of any age is covered by a parent's application to the EUSS. Monday 5<sup>th</sup> July – the children and parents will be informed about new classes and teachers for September 2021


From Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July – there are opportunities for you to discuss your child's report with their teacher – more details to follow.
