September 2021 arrangements

In September some things will change and some things will stay the same, all based on the latest information from the Government.

- Everyone will now be dropped off between 8.35am and 8.45am.
- Registers will be taken at 8.45am and anyone arriving after that time will be recorded as late.
- The one-way system has worked well and will remain in place.
- Staff members will be on the entry and exit gates at drop off and collection times in case you want to speak to a member of staff.
- As it currently stands, face masks will no longer be required. However, throughout September, we will continue to review our measures to ensure everyone remains safe.
- During the school day children will continue to wash their hands frequently and more frequent cleaning good ventilation will remain in place.

- On PE Days, your child will still need to come in school PE Kit instead of school uniform.
- **If your child or anyone in your household has COVID symptoms you will be advised to get a PCR or LFT test/self-isolate etc.**
- During the school day we will be returning to having key stage bubbles so we can ensure all children get the additional support they require.
- Pick up time for all will be at 3.10pm.

We cannot wait to have our children in for full days and starting things like assemblies, visits and inviting parents/carers in in the Autumn Term.

Good Luck to Miss Kemp who is getting married in the summer holidays.


And a final and massive goodbye and good luck to our wonderful Year 4s who will be remembered as a group of children who we will always be proud of.
